Junior levels dancers must be aged 7 years and upwards and have a minimum of one year of dance experience. Students will be grouped according to age / dance level. Students will receive a variety of classes each day in classical ballet, lyrical, musical theatre, hip hop, jazz and modern dance.

## IGNITE! Week 2: August 26 - 30 Ballet & Contemporary Focus

## Monday to Friday 10:00-4:00



For students who have completed a minimum of Royal Academy of Dance Grade 3 or equivalent. Students will receive classes in classical ballet, contemporary, pointe work or pre pointe work as well as Progressing Ballet Technique conditioning.

Examination preparation will be a focus of this week for students entering vocational grades.

Registration Fees: \$400 per week or \$750 for both weeks.
